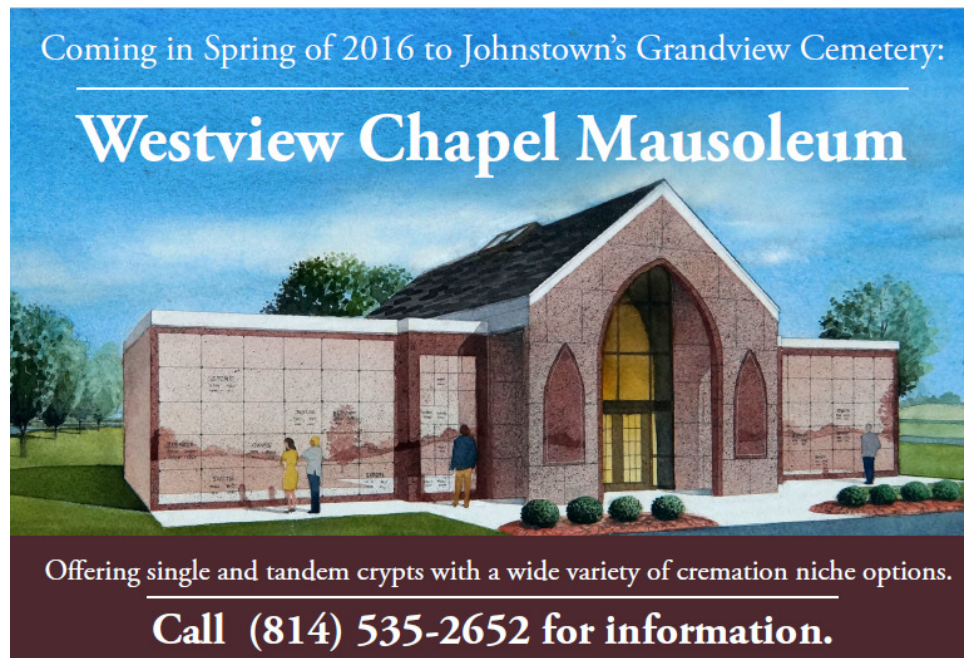


Grandview Cemetery Expands with Building of New Mausoleum

Grandview Cemetery, located in the Southmont Borough area of Johnstown, has announced its plans for expansion with the building of a new, 3,500 square foot, chapel-style mausoleum. This new project, to be named Westview Chapel Mausoleum, will provide a wide selection of crypts and niches for those wishing to choose Grandview Cemetery for entombment services.

The Citizens' Cemetery Board of Trustees agreed to move forward with this project in November of 2014 and have chosen an industry leader in the construction of mausoleums, Ingram Construction, Inc. LLC of Mississippi, to complete the project. Ingram also constructed the most recent mausoleum at Grandview. The new building is expected to be completed in 15 months.



Although the need for a new mausoleum arose because of inventory needs, the cemetery decided to use this opportunity to provide additional options to those individuals and families who choose Grandview Cemetery as their final resting place. The new mausoleum is designed to be a non-denominational, chapel-style building that can be used as space for final entombment or burial services. Entombment options include 120 tandem crypts on the outside of the building, 110 single crypts on the inside of the building (including several oversized crypts and side-by-side crypts) and 64 cremation niches on both the inside and outside of the building.

Specialized features of the new mausoleum will include engraved granite memorialization (instead of traditional bronze). There will also be glass-face, horizontal, vertical, and family cremation niches on the inside of the building.

The design of the new building will allow for future expansion when the need arises, making the mausoleum a solid investment for the future of Grandview Cemetery. Sales of crypts and niches are expected to begin shortly.
